The City of Burlington's new 25-year Strategic Plan gave a clear direction for Burlington Economic Development (Burlington EcDev) to develop a strategy for growing local talent, supporting existing businesses, and nurturing the start-up and growth of new companies. The team hit the ground running, and within a year presented a comprehensive innovation and entrepreneurship strategy that included a recommendation to establish a physical space in Burlington where start-ups and innovation could thrive.
