
Primary

Our palette is bold, saturated and energetic with each colour referencing a unique element of the Kamloops landscape.


Hoodoo, Ponderosa and Sage are our three primary colours and should be used most often.





It's expressive without being too daring and has a healthy dose of warmth and friendliness. In order to avoid appearing overly bold or too delicate we will use only the Medium and Regular weights.

Headline Styling

Sizing

Go big. Be bold. Where appropriate set Clash Display in large sizes. Avoid using Clash Display for smaller headings and subheadings, and instead switch to Sofia Pro Semi Bold.

Tracking

Not too tight, not too loose. Clash Display works best for us when tracking/letter spacing is set at 0.

Leading

Tighten up. Clash tends to run tall so at bigger font sizes reduce leading to ~90% font size. And at smaller sizes increase slightly to 100% for legibility. This is a place where every street and trail are yours to explore, and where wrong turns often lead to the greatest discoveries.

At larger sizes tighten up the tracking slightly by using small negative value. As our copy size decreases set the tracking to 0.

Leading

Give copy room to breathe. Set the line height tall at 150% for larger font sizes and reduce down to 140/130/120 as type becomes much smaller. Clash Display Medium Line height: 90% Letter-spacing: 0
