



**TO BURLINGTON** 

The Cultivated B is a subsidiary of German company InFamily Foods. With Cultivated B as one of three core corporate pillars, InFamily Foods is a leading international supplier of protein solutions. The facility will develop and produce bioreactors from 500 mL ranging up to 25,000 litres, as well as photobioreactors and high-precision devices for cellular agriculture and precision fermentation.

Additionally, approximately 20,000 square feet of the building will become a dedicated innovation hub, offering small and medium sized cellular agriculture and other biotech companies access to laboratory space, bioreactors, and other resources to test and scale their products.

Founded in 1971 by Tony Bosco, ABS Machining has grown into a global leader in high-precision machining, supporting OEMs across the mining, hydro, oil & gas, nuclear, and military sectors. With over 180 skilled, high-paying jobs created and a \$50M+ investment into local developments and machinery assets, ABS continues to make a major economic impact—over \$150M—in Burlington.

Currently undertaking a 250,000 sq. ft. expansion, the company's Burlington footprint will soon total 340,000 sq. ft. of manufacturing space and 10,000 sq. ft. of offices. Initial occupancy is expected by 2027, following a planned construction start in Q3 2026.


