


Over the next decade, our region anticipates the need to fill more than 4,200 positions—engineers, mechanics, technicians, teachers, medical professionals, labourers... the list of opportunities is varied and long. In a November 2023 research report by Deloitte, 38 percent of regional employers reported that their employee base had increased in the past year, and 55 percent expected their numbers to grow again in the next 12 months. The need for qualified talent is substantial and immediate.

Housing prices are relatively low (Single detached home average price is \$322,750 versus \$710,000 and \$485,000 in Calgary and Edmonton), which means you'll have the means to pursue and embrace a deeply satisfying work-life balance. This affordability extends to other areas as well, including utilities and services. The region's lower cost of living is made even more attractive by its comparatively higher median household income—\$102,000 versus the provincial average of \$96,000 (2020).

Our welcoming atmosphere encourages professional connections and mentorship, fostering a supportive environment for career development and personal growth.




A WELCOMING SENSE OF COMMUNITY


A DIVERSE AMATEUR SPORTS SCENE
