## Ec.D. Application Process

### Exam Eligibility

To first apply for Ec.D. accreditation, you must have followed one of three pathways to ensure your ability to write the exam:

**Pathway 1:** 45 points + three years of experience in the Economic Development field

**Pathway 2:** Master's Degree + Year 2 (including the paper)

**Pathway 3:** 10 years of experience in the Economic Development field

### What is experience in the Economic Development field?

The Economic Development Field is defined as the total time a person has worked in roles where their primary duties involve economic development activities, such as:

- Economic Development Officer / Specialist / Coordinator / Manager / Director
- Jobs focused on business attraction, retention and expansion, investment attraction, or community economic development
- Positions in government, NGOs, chambers or agencies where key responsibilities are strategic planning for growth, incentive programs, grant/loan programs, sector development or related policy work
- Related fields like business development, community development or planning are often counted when the work directly supports economic development outcomes, such as the measurable changes in a community's economy and quality of life that result from the economic development activities listed above.

### How many points are courses worth?

Points are allocated depending on the time spent on the course. The following chart is not comprehensive, but will allow you to gain an understanding of how many points you may have:

### Ready to Sit the Exam?

Once you are eligible to write the exam using one of the three pathways, you must submit the following application form, have 3 references submit letters of recommendation directly to the EDAC Office via [kait@edac.ca](mailto:kait@edac.ca) and pay your certification fee of \$275.78 (2026).

Application form, references and fee must be received **NO LATER THAN 2 WEEKS prior** to your exam date. You will receive a login and password for the exam **1 WEEK PRIOR** to your exam date. This login and password will allow you to open the exam using our online platform. You will also receive a Teams invite for the day of the exam. Your video must remain on for the duration of the exam.

### Exam Format

Please expect to spend about 3 - 5 hours on the exam. Format is as follows:




